

PRACTICE MATERIAL FOR SPELLATHON

(GRADE 5)

1. Nature Poster

Details: Create a poster that highlights a specific natural habitat (e.g., rainforest, desert, ocean). Include at least three facts about the habitat, an illustration or photograph, and decorative elements.

Judging Rubric:

- **Creativity (25 points):** Originality of design and concept.
- **Information (25 points):** Relevance and accuracy of facts presented.
- **Visual Appeal (25 points):** Effective use of colors, images, and layout.
- **Organization (25 points):** Clarity in presenting information and layout.

2. Book Recommendation Flyer

Details: Design a flyer recommending a book you've read. Include the book's title, author, a brief summary, and reasons why others should read it, along with an engaging image.

Judging Rubric:

- **Creativity (25 points):** Originality of design and layout.
- **Clarity (25 points):** Effectiveness in summarizing the book.
- **Visual Appeal (25 points):** Use of images and color schemes.
- **Engagement (25 points):** Ability to capture the audience's interest.

3. Character Creation

Details: Design a character for an original story. Include an illustration of the character, a name, and a brief description of their personality and background.

Judging Rubric:

- **Creativity (25 points):** Originality of the character concept.
- **Visual Appeal (25 points):** Quality and detail of the illustration.
- **Character Development (25 points):** Depth of description and background.
- **Clarity (25 points):** Readability of text and organization.

4. Event Poster

Details: Create a poster for a fictional school event, such as a science fair or talent show. Include the event name, date, time, location, and a brief description of activities.

Judging Rubric:

- **Clarity (25 points):** Clear presentation of event details.
- **Creativity (25 points):** Unique design elements and concept.
- **Visual Appeal (25 points):** Effective use of colors and images.
- **Engagement (25 points):** Ability to attract interest in the event.

5. Digital Collage

Details: Make a digital collage that represents a theme you are passionate about (e.g., friendship, sports, or animals). Use a mix of images, textures, and text to convey your theme.

Judging Rubric:

- **Creativity (25 points):** Originality and uniqueness of the collage.
- **Visual Appeal (25 points):** Effective arrangement of images and use of color.
- **Theme Representation (25 points):** Clarity in conveying the chosen theme.
- **Organization (25 points):** Clarity in layout and flow of elements.
