1. Infographic on a Social Issue

Details: Create an infographic that highlights a social issue you care about (e.g., bullying, climate change, or health). Include key statistics, images, and concise text to convey your message effectively.

Judging Rubric:

- **Creativity (25 points):** Originality and uniqueness of the design.
- **Clarity of Information (25 points):** Effectiveness in presenting key statistics and facts.
- **Visual Appeal (25 points):** Use of colors, fonts, and layout.
- **Engagement (25 points):** Ability to capture and maintain viewer interest.

2. Magazine Cover

Details: Design a magazine cover on a topic of your choice (e.g., sports, fashion, or science). Include a catchy title, headlines, and images that reflect the theme.

Judging Rubric:

- **Creativity (25 points):** Originality and uniqueness of the cover design.
- **Visual Appeal (25 points):** Aesthetic quality, including images and colors.
- **Clarity (25 points):** Readability of text and organization of elements.
- **Relevance (25 points):** Connection to the chosen theme.

3. Character Design for a Story

Details: Create a visual design for an original character in a story. Include an illustration, name, and a brief description of their personality, background, and role in the story.

Judging Rubric:

- **Creativity (25 points):** Originality in character concept and design.

- **Visual Appeal (25 points):** Quality and detail of the illustration.
- **Character Development (25 points):** Depth and clarity of description.
- **Organization (25 points):** Clarity in layout and readability of text.

4. Event Promotion Poster

Details: Design a poster promoting a fictional event (like a concert, sports tournament, or charity fundraiser). Include event details such as name, date, time, location, and activities.

Judging Rubric:

- **Clarity (25 points):** Clear presentation of all event details.
- **Creativity (25 points):** Unique design elements and approach.
- **Visual Appeal (25 points):** Effective use of colors, fonts, and images.
- **Engagement (25 points):** Ability to attract interest and excitement about the event.

5. Digital Timeline

Details: Create a digital timeline that highlights important events in a historical period or your life. Use images, icons, and short descriptions to illustrate each event.

Judging Rubric:

- **Creativity (25 points):** Originality of timeline design and concept.
- **Clarity (25 points):** Ease of understanding the timeline.
- **Visual Appeal (25 points):** Use of images, colors, and layout.
- **Detail (25 points):** Inclusion of significant events and relevant information.
